

## Medicare's Limited Income NET Program

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### Medicare's Limited Income NET Program (LI NET) 60 Day Days Supply Limit

#### What's happening?

Effective February 8, 2018 Medicare's Limited Income NET program (LI NET) will limit the days supply for prescription drugs to no more than a **60-day dispense per fill**. The maximum days supply for the below mentioned scenarios, will remain the same:

- **Hepatitis C drugs**- maximum days supply is **30**
- **Opioids**- maximum days supply is **30**
- **Unconfirmed beneficiaries** (beneficiaries who have not been deemed eligible for LI NET)- maximum days supply is **34**

#### How will this impact the beneficiary?

Many beneficiaries will not be impacted because this does not change anything for those receiving a 30-day supply of medication.

**If the pharmacy attempts to fill a medication with a days supply greater than 60 days, the claim will reject immediately, prompting the pharmacist to reduce the days supply.**

An NCPDP error code 76 "Plan limitation exceeds" with additional error messaging "Days supply is more than allowed by the plan; submit value < or =60" will be returned to the pharmacy.

**Beneficiaries who require** a days supply greater than 60 days should file a Coverage Determination Exception request with **LI NET**.
